- 1.) **Exhibit Dates** – October 6 – October 31, 2016
Opening Reception – October 6, 5 – 9 PM
- 2.) **Eligible work** – Any work in any medium, preferably interpretive, experimental, difficult, conceptual, or subversive.
- 3.) **Submission** – Submit up to 5 digital entries [images & all corresponding tag info: title / medium / size / sale price] to braydee@gordyframing.com **by midnight Tuesday, SEPT. 20th.**

Late and/or incomplete submissions will not be considered. Really, guys, look at the timeline here.

*** Due to increased interest in participation and limited exhibit space, this event is curated.
Notification of accepted submissions will be sent out FRIDAY, SEPT 23rd.

Proposals for installation work will be considered, please think about the limits of our gallery space, include thorough details, and email in advance with questions. Video, performance, and intermedia work will be considered for exhibit in Civic's Black Box Theatre as an extension of MT6 under the direction of Maura Jasper. All accepted 2D/wall installed work must be complete with hanging hardware (wires preferred). All 3D work to be viewed in the round must be securely free-standing or able to sit on pedestals no larger than 12"w x 12"d. Any artist exhibiting installation-heavy artwork, including video & intermedia pieces, should plan to be responsible for the installation of that work.

- 4.) EVERYTHING in the show needs to be FOR SALE! Not only does Monkey Thunder serve as an outlet for introducing patrons to work of this nature, but also shows them that it is indeed purchasable and perfectly acceptable to own.
- 5.) Because each artwork is required to be for sale, and because the goal is to move some of it into private collections, our gallery commission will be cut to 20%. Hopefully, this will help everyone keep their prices on the Muncie side of affordable.
- 6.) **Accepted artwork** should be dropped off at Gordy Fine Art & Framing Co. (224 E. Main St. Muncie) Monday, October 3rd or Tuesday, October 4th during normal business hours, 9 AM – 5:30 PM.

Artwork pick-up will be Monday, October 31st or Tuesday, November 1st during normal business hours.
